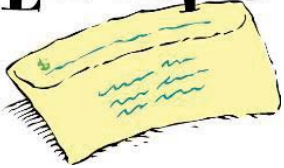

Sunday Offering Envelopes for 2021 are now available!!

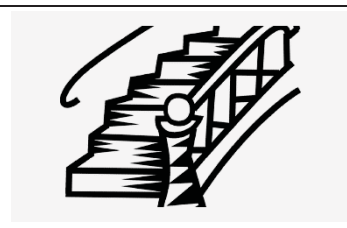
Please pick up your 2021 envelopes by giving your name to a screener at the door and they will retrieve your donation envelopes for you.

OUR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS – VIRTUE OF THE MONTH

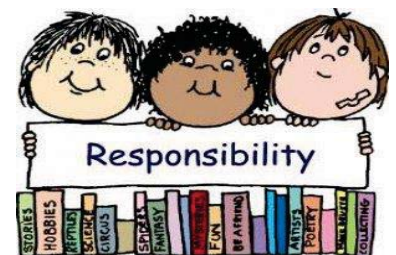
During the month of January, our Catholic Schools are celebrating the value of
