Distributing and Receiving of Holy Communion

Taken from a letter published by the Most Reverend Jean-Louis Plouffe in September 22, 2011, (for those who are able to) "communion is to be received standing, preferably, in the hand because of the hygienic reasons. It can also be received on the tongue. Everyone is asked to stop and make a simple bow of the head before receiving Holy Communion and to consume it immediately." (160)
