Inch by inch, foot by foot... Last month we removed the first row of pews from the front of the church to allow for a better space for those in wheel chairs and scooters as well as to facilitate the Communion Procession. This past week we removed two rows of pews from the back entrance. Our desire was to create a more spacious area for ministers before and after Mass and those entering and exiting the church. There is now a very noticeable open and welcoming feeling as one enters the church. This new space at the entrance, will help us to visualize a redesign and positioning of one set of Confessionals to make them more "user friendly", wheelchair and walker friendly etc, while still having the option for privacy. Please be patient as we strive to improve the appearance of the flooring in the front and back in this transition.

The pews removed from the main floor of the church, a number of pews from the choir loft and about 5 old pews in storage in the bell towers where given to the Coptic Church Congregation who have purchased the former St. Matthew's Church in McFarland Lake.
