A few months ago we offered parishioners the opportunity to express their thoughts, comments, ideas, etc. through our "Ideas" box. Many great ideas have been generated. Thank you all for your comments, they have all been read and here are a few highlights of the comments and what has been done to act on those great suggestions...

- Song numbers posted on song board at the beginning of Masses
- Give credit to groups who helped in the Loose-Change Soup Lunch.
- Lights in the church will be left at full brightness until about 5 minutes before Mass and then they would be dimmed until just before Mass to provide a signal for people to enter into a sacred silence. The lights would be brought up again just before Mass to provide a signal to the choir.
- The possibility of moving the choir out of the balcony is being considered so that those who have difficulty climbing stairs may join in the choir.
- Start processions of the side aisles earlier or start with the center aisles and do the side aisles last for an easier flow for communion.

SAINTS' CORNER

Saint Anne and Saint Joachim... There are no references to Mary's parents in the Scriptures but a cult of Saint Anne is known since the sixth century in the Church and both their names were included in the Roman calendar in 1584. All we know about Jesus' grandparents are found in the Proto-gospel of James which tells the lamentation of Joachim about his childless marriage, his fast and the reference to Abram and Sarai. Canada (and Sudbury) has a history to both Saints (Saint Anne de Beaufre, Saint Joachim, Que. and Sainte Anne-des-Pins) with worships, beautiful buildings, legends, history and pilgrimages.
