...SAINT'S CORNER

Our parish's beautiful stained glass window (first to the left of the church when you enter from the main doors) is devoted to **Saint Margaret Mary Alcoque** ~ the *originator* of the *Devotion to the Sacred Heart*.



Born in 1647 in France, she was sent to the Poor Clares' school at the age of eight on the early death of her father. She was then bedridden for five years with rheumatic fever until she was fifteen years old and developed a devotion to the *Blessed Sacrament*. She refused marriage and entered a convent and at age twenty started to experience visions of Christ. In them, Christ informed her she was his chosen instrument to spread devotion to his Sacred Heart, instructed her in a devotion that was to become known as the *"nine Fridays and the Holy Hour"* and asked that the *feast of the Sacred Heart* be established. Margaret died in 1690 and was canonized in 1920 (Source: *Dictionary of Saints*, by John. J. Delaney, 1980:page 35).
