**Annual Mass of CHRISM**



Once a year, just before Easter, all the priests of the Diocese gather with the Bishop for a special Mass at which oils, used in various Sacraments, are blessed: Oil of the Sick, Oil of Catechumens, and Oil of Chrism. This year the gathering will be celebrated at our parish of **Christ the King**, on **Thursday, April 11, at 7 p.m.** All are invited to join in this special diocesan celebration.

If you are interested in **joining the choir** for the Mass of Chrism, rehearsals will be held at **our parish** of Christ the King at **7:00 p.m., on the following Mondays: March 25<sup>th</sup>, April 1<sup>st</sup>, and April 8<sup>th</sup>**. **FURTHER CLARIFICATIONS ON THE BISHOP'S IMPLEMENTED PLAN**

With the announcement, last Sunday, that Bishop Marcel will be searching for a new Priest ("Pastor" or "Parochial Administrator") to serve Christ the King Parish, he also shared that he has "implemented a plan so that the parish can continue to provide the pastoral and sacramental services, along with all the administrative responsibilities."



In that regard, for the sake of good order, on March 4, 2019, he has assigned Monsignor James Hutton and Deacon Roland Muzzatti to address "questions pertaining to pastoral and sacramental needs of the parish."



Priests have been assigned by the Bishop to cover until the end of April: daily Masses as usual, Sunday Masses and Funerals. Each Sunday, the Priest covering for that week will be listed in the parish bulletin.

He has also assigned Mr. Ted Hargreaves (Diocesan Financial Administrator), "to help with any decision making in regards to administration and property maintenance" in collaboration with the Parish Finance Committee.
