I embrace You, for You are already there, and unite myself totally to You. Amen.

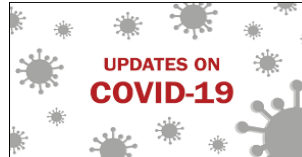
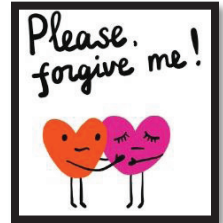

## **CONFIRMATION 2022**
