**Annual Mass of CHRISM**

Once a year, just before Easter, all the priests of the Diocese gather with the Bishop for a special Mass at which oils, used in various Sacraments, are blessed: Oil of the Sick, Oil of Catechumens, and Oil of Chrism. This year the gathering will be celebrated at our parish of **Christ the King**, on **Thursday, April 11, at 7 p.m.** All are invited to join in this special diocesan celebration.

SHARE LENT COLLECTION 2019 - The Share Lent Collection will be taken up in parishes on **April 6th & 7th**. The collection for Share Lent (Development and Peace) is taken on the **Fifth Sunday of Lent**. The organization was founded by the Bishops of Canada and carries out its work in developing countries. This collection will be totaled and sent to the Development & Peace through the Diocesan Office.

A Saint's Corner. Not too long ago we celebrated the life of Angela Merici, Saint and Founder of the *Ursulines* from Brescia, Italy; officially recognized as the *Order of Saint Ursula* by the Church in 1544. Moving ahead about ninety years to Canada, and we meet a lady from France, Marie Guyard, who arrived in Quebec in 1639. By 1641, the foundation for a monastery was laid, and the Ursuline Order was established in North America. Marie is known for her piety, hard work, her concern in caring, and for teaching not only Europeans, but also the indigenous people for 33 years. She is credited with founding the first girls' school in North America. She made great efforts to learn new languages, suffered through war and composed a 'catechism' for young religious women. **Saint Marie of the Incarnation** was beatified in 1980 and canonized in 2014. Her Feast day is April 30th.
