The colour purple is a very symbolic colour in the church throughout Lent (Lent = a German word for "spring") for two reasons: 1) purple is associated with mourning and so anticipates the pain and suffering of the crucifixion, and 2) purple is associated with royalty, and celebrates Christ's resurrection and sovereignty.

Development & Peace... Sowing seeds of justice for women and girls in Nigeria: *"Doubly poor are those women who endure situations of exclusion, mistreatment, and violence, since they are frequently less able to defend their rights. Even so, we constantly witness among them impressive examples of daily heroism in defending and protecting their vulnerable families."*

Supporting women and girls is a priority for D&P. When 276 girls were kidnapped by Boko Haram from Chibok in Nigeria, our local Nigerian partner began working for their freedom, and has managed to smuggle three girls to safety. "The three girls, who were 17, 18, and 19 years old, still seemed to be under the effect of the swirl of emotions generated by the trials they experienced since their abduction," states Raphael Yimga Tatchi, Development and Peace program officer Nigeria. "Their voices and lost eyes betray deep pain... glimmers of humanity shine through only when they courageously recount the details of their escape." **Breaking News:** Fr. 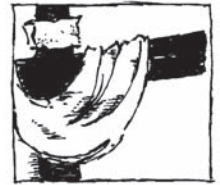
