How to Go To Confession...

1. Enter into the Reconciliation Room, and either kneeling behind the screen or sitting in front of the priest, begin with the Sign of the Cross.
2. Then say, "Bless me Father for I have sinned, it has been ___ months since my last Confession, these are my sins..."
3. Briefly tell the priest your sins, and he will then counsel you, giving you a helpful penance.
4. You will then be asked to say an "Act of Contrition".
5. The priest will then extend his hand over your head and pray over you the "Prayer of Absolution".
6. The priest will then say, "You may go in peace". You may respond in saying, "Thank you".
