**Gentle Reminder...** Due to the Holy Week, there will be no *funerals with Masses* celebrated in this parish on Good Friday (Mar 25th) and Holy Saturday (Mar 26th).

**PASCHAL FAST...** Good Friday is a day of Paschal Fast to honour the suffering and death of the Lord and to help us prepare to share more deeply in the joy of the resurrection. Catholics are to abstain from meat and those between the ages of 14 – 59 are encouraged to fast between meals. We might also consider eating more moderately during this time. In this way, the people of God will receive the joys of the Lord's resurrection with uplifted and responsive hearts (ORDO: 169).
