A Note about Weddings and Funerals at our parish... Many marriages have been postponed due to the pandemic. These are extremely difficult decisions to make and Fr. Raymond and Deacon Roland continue to pray for all of our couples who are rescheduling their weddings.



Fr. Raymond also continues to work with funeral homes/burial service agencies and families to meet



the needs of the grieving families as best as he can during these difficult days. The current government restrictions during the pandemic allow only 10 people (including the priest) present at a funeral liturgy/graveside burial. ***We ask God to give all families, who are mourning the loss of a loved one, the grace and strength they need during this pandemic.***

To our youth and children, ***we miss you!*** During these days when we are restricted from gathering in our churches, we really miss all our children, young people, and families! For those of you in our Sacramental Preparation Program for First Communion, keep up with your readings and good work as your classes and celebration will resume once we are given the green light. First Prayer:

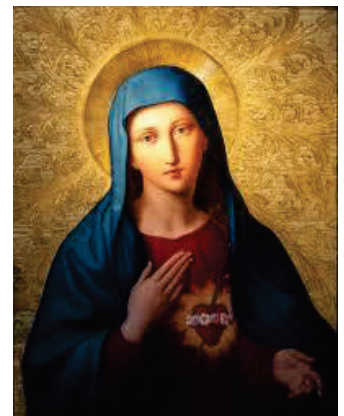
