## Earthquake in Nepal

On the morning of April 25, a massive earthquake measuring 7.8 on the

Richter scale struck Nepal and part of neighbouring India. The epicenter was just 80 km from the capital Kathmandu where the destruction is major. It is expected that the number of victims increases in the coming hours and days. Nepal is one of the poorest countries on the planet. Its infrastructure is not designed to cope with the strength of this type of earthquake, the most devastating in over a century. Since this morning, Development and Peace is in constant communication with the General Secretariat of Caritas Internationalis. The information we have received from Caritas Nepal, Caritas India, and Catholic Relief Services' office in India leads us to believe that Nepal is going through a major crisis. The director of Caritas Nepal, Father Pius Perumana, is in Kathmandu where he said: *"This is the worst earthquake I have experienced in my life. The aftershocks are still strong. The evidence indicates that this is a major emergency."* Development and Peace is receiving donations from the public to support the efforts of local organizations to meet the needs of victims. In the face of this tragedy, our prayers are turned towards our sisters and brothers from Nepal and neighbouring India. On Sunday, May 10, the **SudburyROCKS!!! Race, Run or Walk for Diabetes** will be taking place and your church is on the race route. This means that participants from across Canada (and even some from the US) will be passing by your doors taking part in the marathon, team marathon relay, half marathon, 10km, 5km or 1k Kids events!

We need YOUR help to make this event a success and to ensure the safety of our participants and volunteers.

We wish to impact your service as little as possible and run times have been adjusted to provide the best accommodation for both runners and parishioners of Ste. Anne des Pins and the Church of Christ the King. But please be aware there will be runners in the downtown area when you are coming to and from Mass. Our early run starts do minimize most of the potential conflicts and we will be providing extra marshals on Ste. Anne Rd. to assist traffic and runners in that area.

The start / finish of the event has moved from Durham street to Minto St (between Brady and Medina Ave). The main race starts at 9:00 AM meaning St. Anne road will be busiest before the 9:30 service.

Please be aware of the partial lane closure of Elgin St. and Ste. Anne Rd. as well as the parking restrictions on the same streets. Pylons will be placed on downtown streets and along the entire race course.

**Note: Only Minto St. is closed between Brady and Medina Ave. There is access to all other streets.**

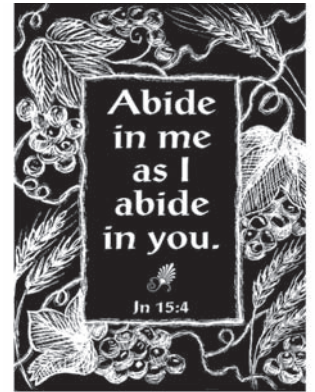
