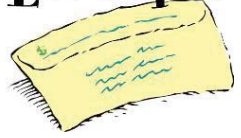

Please register by email or phone. Please provide you name, phone number and the number of people in your household bubble.

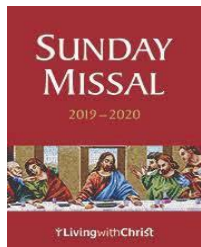

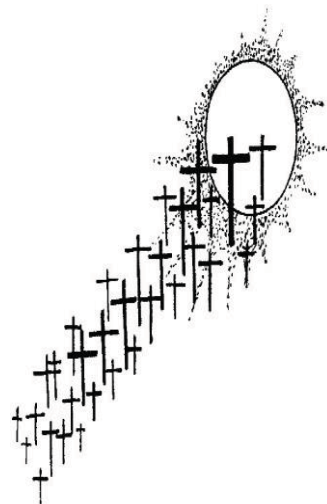
