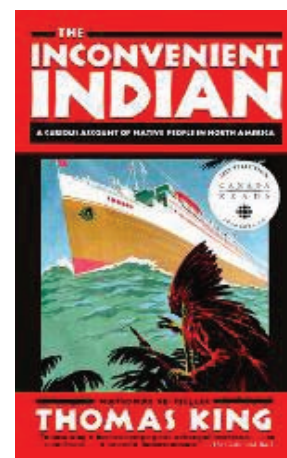


Christ the King Truth & Reconciliation Book Club

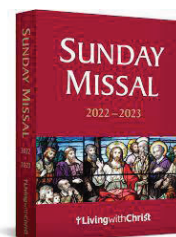
