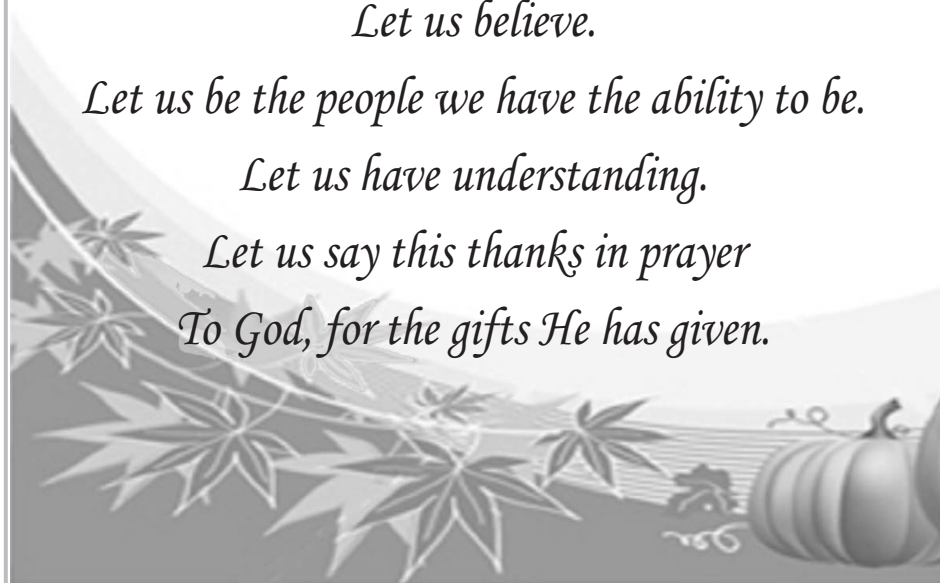

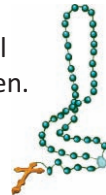

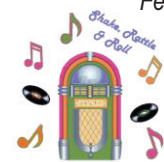
The parish **Men's Club** will hold their **General Meeting and Election on October 15th at 7 pm** in the Sacristy.

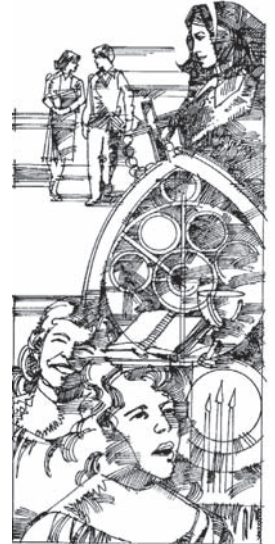
