SUNDAY MASS TIME POLL

As a reminder... Initiated by the Liturgy Committee and Parish Council, the survey of parishioners taken in June, found that:

- **63% - YES** – in favour of one Sunday Mass at 10:15 am (i.e. not only as a trial)
- **20% - NO** - did not want the 10:15 am Sunday Mass to continue beyond the trial”
- **16% - did not know** - (whether undecided or they didn't really care, is not known)

On the same survey, many gave the suggestion of a 10:00 am Mass was wanted instead of 10:15 am.

Next weekend, **Sept 22nd-23rd**, at each of the Masses, parishioners will be handed a ballot. As you exit the church you will be able to cast your “vote” by placing your ballot into one of three boxes:

1st Choice: Sunday 9:30 am and 11:00 am (back to regular schedule).

2nd Choice: Sunday 10:15 am **only**

3rd Choice: Sunday 10:00 am **only**

On the weekend of September 29-30th, those who are not in attendance next weekend will have an opportunity to cast their ballot.

*The Pastoral Council will receive the results and inform the parish and the city churches of what will be our Sunday Mass time. **Saturday Mass remains at 5pm.***

In 1984, in commemoration of the annual International Day of Peace and in solidarity with the United Nations, the NGO

“Pathways To Peace”

inaugurated the **Minute of Silence** at 12:00 Noon in each time zone, resulting in a “Peace Wave” around the world. Individuals, organizations, communities and nations are invited to participate in this shared and practical act of peace building on September 21.



The Out of the Cold Program (OOTC) is a 20-year-old outreach program initially begun by St. Andrew's United Church volunteers. A hot, nutritious meal is served every Friday evening from **November to April** at either St. Andrew's Place or Church of the Epiphany Anglican Church. Approximately 175 to 250 people are fed every week by volunteers who are attempting to create a warm and comfortable environment, and to make guests feel at home and part of the community. This program is financially supported by the Out of the Cold Concert Series that runs every fall and by generous donations from the community of Sudbury. **Christ the King volunteers** became a part of this program last year. For the coming season, **the Catholic Women's League, the Men's Club, and the Knights of Columbus,** have agreed to cook on one Friday each. While we have a committed team, we extend an **invitation to all parishioners** to be part of this program. **If you have 2 hours to spend on any Friday,** spares are needed; please consider becoming part of the Christ the King team. We also ask that you pray that God guide us in this Ministry. **A team member will be available after Mass on Saturday Sept. 22** to answer any questions.
