The time has come to thank Connor O'Hara for his services to St. Francis de Sales Parish during this last year. Connor began his service with us last September as part of his seminary training to be able to experience parish life by experiencing actually living and working in a parish. For his first few months he was able to be with Fr. Kevin for weekday and weekend masses, he was present at all funerals, weddings and baptisms. He also was able to accompany Fr. Kevin on his hospital visits, and in ministering to people in nursing homes and hospice. He was able also to be present to the students at St. Anne's School and to St. Joseph's High School, where he worked with the Chaplain in organizing sessions with some students. He attended the parish meetings and was present with us for most of the functions that occur on a regular basis.

Unfortunately, on 15th March things changed radically. All meetings were cancelled, parish functions were discontinued and even the church was closed and parishioners were no longer able to gather for mass or prayer. Connor was given the option - he could return home to his parents or he could stay here in our parish community. He chose to stay here. Because of his presence, even though we were not able to have public masses, he and Fr. Kevin celebrated mass each day. When Easter approached, we decided to try a new project called 'live streaming' and he was able to use his capabilities to make this possible. Thanks to his willingness we have been able to live stream mass since Holy Thursday. As restrictions began to be lifted and we were allowed certain functions, he has been present, not only to live stream, but also to act as the reader and Eucharistic Minister for our daily and Sunday celebrations.

He will be leaving us on 30th August to return to St. Augustine's Seminary to continue his studies towards priesthood. It is our hope that his experience among us helped him to clarify his vision of priesthood and that in two years time we may welcome him back as Fr. Connor O'Hara.
