

REPAIRS

Repairs for the basement section of the church are on-going. When the church was reconstructed it was rebuilt on the old foundation and weeping tiles were not installed. The result is that with aging and deterioration we have had water leakage. Last year we worked on the south end of the church by digging out the foundation and applying sealer in order to avoid the problem of leaking. This year we will be doing the front north section which will be underneath the stairs and the northeast side of the church. The work will begin this week and that will mean there will be hazard signs and fencing in the northeast corner. We would ask you to be careful and to obey the safety rules in order to avoid injury.

For parishioners who attend daily mass during the time of construction, it might be better if you park in the west parking lot and to use the west side of the stairs or even the back stairs for the next few weeks.
