REPAIRS

Repairs for the basement section of the church are on-going. When the church was reconstructed it was rebuilt on the old foundation and weeping tiles were not installed. The result is that with aging and deterioration we have had water leakage. Last year we worked on the south end of the church by digging out the foundation and applying sealer in order to avoid the problem of leaking. This year we will be doing the front north section which will be underneath the stairs and the northeast side of the church. The work will begin this week and that will mean there will be hazard signs and fencing in the northeast corner. We would ask you to be careful and to obey the safety rules in order to avoid injury.

For parishioners who attend daily mass during the time of construction, it might be better if you park in the west parking lot and to use the west side of the stairs or even the back stairs for the next few weeks.

NEW FLOORING

Earlier in the summer, we mentioned that we would also be doing new flooring for the interior of the church. We put out tenders for the job and the successful bidder was Mainville Flooring of Cornwall. This work will be beginning this Monday, 12th August, and we hope to have it completed within two weeks. In order to give the workmen all the time they need, the weekday masses will be celebrated in the Parish Hall. We would ask those who are attending weekday masses to access the hall either from the rear entrance or the double doors facing Second Street. The project will be worked in two stages; the first stage will involve the body of the church and it is hoped that this will be completed within the first week. The second stage will involve the sanctuary and the board room and these will be done in the second week.
