## MASS INTENTIONS

#### Part 3 - Why do we have Mass intentions?

Even though every Mass is celebrated for the whole community (the living and the dead) sometimes a family may request that special prayers be asked for a particular individual or need. These special prayers are called a Mass Intention. At such a Mass the celebrant not only prays for that particular intention but asks those who are gathered for the celebration to join him in praying for that intention. Sometimes when a person dies, family members or friends will give what is known as a Mass card in order to show the family their support and prayers in their time of grieving. The Mass card is more than a sympathy card. It is an acknowledgement that a Christian community will be asked to pray for our loved one who has died.
