CELEBRATE THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY

Calvary in Green Valley is looking spectacular! Located behind Ste-Marie-de-l'Assomption parish (4172 County Road 34), Calvary is an outdoor Way of the Cross and pilgrimage site. It is open daily and is a great place to slow down and escape the busyness of everyday life. **On Tuesday, 15th August, Archbishop Marcel will preside a bilingual Mass at 7:00 p.m., as we celebrate the Assumption of Mary.** Following Mass, we will pray the Stations of the Cross. We invite in a special way all Acadians to the outdoor Mass. Our Lady of the Assumption is the patron saint of all Acadians. August 15th is National Acadian Day and has been celebrated since 1881.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

This August, we remember the birth and death of Blessed Michael J. McGivney: a devoted Catholic priest born on 12 August 1852 and passed away on 14 August 1890. He founded the Knights of Columbus in 1882 to aid Catholic families facing financial hardships due to premature deaths. Since then, the Knights of Columbus has grown into a vast Catholic fraternal group dedicated to charity, unity and fraternity, actively supporting various Church and community initiatives.

Venerable Michael McGivney's cause for canonization began in 1997, and he was declared Venerable by Pope Saint John Paul II in 2008. On 27 May 2020 Pope Francis attributed a miracle to his intercession, leading to his beatification on 31 October 2020.

Blessed Michael McGivney's life and work continue to inspire Catholics worldwide, particularly members of the Knights of Columbus, to live a life of faith, service and devotion to God and their fellow beings.

At every meeting of the Knights, we pray that Blessed Michael McGivney may inspire us to continue his work of caring for the needy and the outcast. Please join us in prayer for the strengthening of our universal Church and the mission that Jesus gives us all.

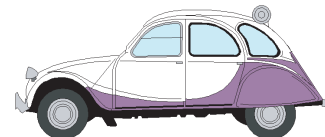
