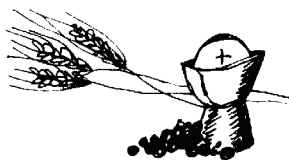

**THE "BIG POTATOES" OF LIFE**

Years ago, Chinese farmers decided they would eat the good big potatoes and just use the small ones for seed. 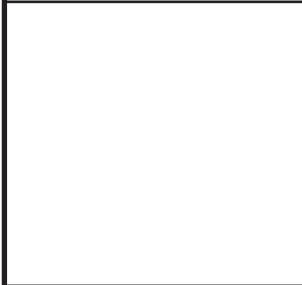
