On October 7, 1934, George Michael Malonev was born to Ambrose and Leafy Isobel Maloney, the 10th child of 13 siblings. He was born and raised on the family farm at St. Andrews West and was baptized at St Andrews church where he also made his First Communion and Confirmation. The family homestead was large with seven bedrooms and no luxuries of modern day amenities. Fr George was a good student and completed his primary and secondary education at St Andrews and was taught by the sisters of St Joseph. While he was at school he played a variety of sports from hockey, baseball and lacrosse to name a few. During his school years he served as an altar boy at St Andrews. Growing up there was a strong resemblance between Fr. George and his brother Morris resulting in Morris often getting blamed for many misbehaviour pranks by his brother. He enjoyed being with his family including aunts, uncles and cousins and watching them playing cards at the kitchen table while doing his homework. Playing cards became a favourite pastime as well as listening and dancing to Irish music especially on St Patrick's Day and throughout the year. Fr George helped his parents work the family farm and thus a strong work ethic and faith was instilled in him which included the rosary as a daily prayer. This combination of faith and work ethic led to his calling to the priesthood.

After completing secondary school, he studied Philosophy at Holy Apostles Seminary, Laprairie, Quebec. During this time he took a couple of years off from his studies to work and travel to other areas of the country before completing his studies for the priesthood at Grand Seminary Christ the King, St Hyacinthe, Quebec. Fr George was ordained on May 11, 1961 by His Excellency Rev. Msgr. Rosario Brodeur, Bishop of Alexandria, in the parish of St Andrews. After his ordination he



was stationed at the Bishop's House in Alexandria for three months before his assignment as curate to St Francis de Sales with Fr. Manny Lefebvre and then transferred to St Columban's as curate with Mgrs. R.J. McDonald. He served as parish priest at Blessed Sacrament, St Francis de Sales, St Peter's and then reappointed to St Francis de Sales in 2005 until the present. He celebrated his 50th anniversary of ordination in May 2011.

When he became a priest he willingly took on the requests of many family members to administer at baptisms, weddings and funerals. His family now and over the years have been very important to him. Fr George is a prominent figure in the community and has served on many boards during his years as a priest and has been very generous towards worthy causes from the United Way, Children's Treatment Centre, St Vincent de Paul to name a few. Over the years he served as Chaplain to many of the parish schools as well as the C.W.L. and Spiritual Advisor to the Knights of Columbus. He is well known for visiting the sick in the hospitals, nursing homes and private homes taking communion to the shut-ins on First Fridays and always on call for those seeking his advice or friendship.
