The Lenten season begins on **Ash Wednesday**. The following are guidelines of Lenten observance.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence.

Friday's are days of abstinence

Fasting binds all persons who have completed their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday through those who have completed their 59<sup>th</sup> year, unless prevented by poor health. On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's own needs. Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.

However, certain pertinent information needs to be addressed before we look at any recruitment of volunteers.

However, if the volunteer position you are interested in includes hospital visitation, home visitation with seniors, children's liturgy, involvement with the youth or collection counters, you will be requested to have a mandatory police check through our diocesan system.
