Scott joined the Companions of the Cross because of key elements of its vision: unquestioned fidelity to the Church, life-giving brotherhood, openness to the ways of the Holy Spirit, love for the Blessed Mother, and its evangelical mission. He was elected General Superior of the Society in 2006, was re-elected in 2012, and he is presently still serving in this assignment.

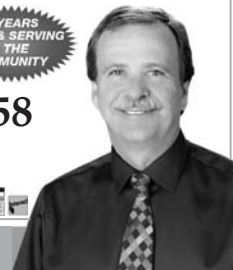
