SACRAMENTS OF HEALING - PART 3

We have talked about the sacrament of the sick as an important part of Christ's ministry and also who should receive the sacrament. This week I would like to explain how the sacrament will be celebrated. The service will begin at 1:30 p.m. and we will have music, prayers, gospel reading and a reflection. The sacrament will be administered with two gestures. The first will be the calling down upon the Spirit to bring healing on those present. Secondly, those who wish to be anointed will be invited forward and the priest will lay his hands upon their head and anoint their forehead and the palms of their hands. For those who have mobility problems, we will go to them so that they do not have to stand too long. After everyone has had the opportunity to be anointed there will be a final prayer and a blessing.

Since many people have felt isolation because of their illnesses there will be receptions available in the hall afterwards. Please note that masks will be available for those who are uncomfortable in being in a crowded area.

I had said I would begin with my concerns with respect to the sick, the vulnerable and the home-bound parishioners of St. Francis de Sales. However, certain pertinent information needs to be addressed before we look at any recruitment of volunteers.

However, if the volunteer position you are interested in includes hospital visitation, home visitation with seniors, children's liturgy, involvement with the youth or collection counters, you will be requested to have a mandatory police check through our diocesan system.

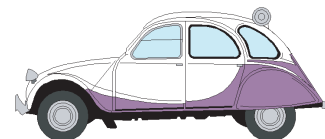
