#### BAPTISM OF THE LORD



A religious baptism is also a rite of initiation. Jesus' baptism called for conversion and repentance which are life-altering choices. Jesus submitted to this rite and waded into the Jordan River in solidarity with people who were searching for the Messiah. When we received the sacrament of Baptism, we became God's children and a new life was

offered to us. From that time on, we can expect to experience daily conversions because we have chosen to become Christians and belong to Christ's family.

John's baptismal rite was intimately associated with the Jordan, this mythical river in whose waters the crowds waded. Water is still the privileged sign of Christian Baptism. It signifies that we have plunged into the depths of God's love. Through Baptism, we are formally welcomed into God's family and acknowledge Christ as our brother. Baptism opens the door to an enhanced future since the sacrament isn't a once in a lifetime offer, but will support us as we make our daily choices. In order for any of this to occur, we must first plunge figuratively and faithfully into the waters of the Jordan River. We will then resurface as more rigorous and invigorated people and better Christians.
