#### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

An important part of Christ's ministry was the ministry of healing. The Gospels are full of stories of many miracles that Jesus performed. Some were physical healings and some were spiritual healings (the forgiveness of sins, and the casting out of evil spirits.) The Church has maintained the importance of this ministry by celebrating two sacraments of healing. We are all very well aware of the sacrament of reconciliation (penance or confession) and many of us have received this sacrament often, but are we equally aware and familiar with the other sacrament of healing, namely "the anointing of the sick"? For far too many of us this sacrament has been considered to be the sacrament of the dying, but in reality this sacrament was meant to be a sacrament of healing. It is not meant to be only when we are dying, but a sacrament which works with medical science to pray for healing for those who are seriously ill of mind or body.

Pope Francis has encouraged priests to invite the sick to receive this sacrament of healing. He has asked that a day for the sacrament could be celebrated on 11<sup>th</sup> February, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. In response to his request, we will have a **prayer service** (not Mass) on **Sunday**, 11<sup>th</sup> **February at 1:30 p.m.** I encourage you to invite family and friends to join us in this celebration.
