#### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING - PART 2

Because many of us were under the impression that the sacrament of the anointing of the sick was meant for the dying, we have missed the opportunity of receiving the spiritual help available for serious and chronic illness.

Who then can receive this sacrament?

1. Those who have a serious and an ongoing illness and those who are undergoing treatments (example: chemo or radiation).
2. Those who have a chronic condition that affects the quality of their life. (example: asthma, COPD, arthritis, diabetes).
3. Those who are suffering from emotional or mental illness (example: depression or other ongoing emotional problems). This sacrament does not replace psychiatrists or psychologists.
4. Those who are suffering from addictions that are causing serious problems and continue to be a problem (the sacrament does not replace programs that deal with addictions).

Pope Francis has encouraged priests to invite the sick to receive this sacrament of healing. He has asked that a day for the sacrament could be celebrated on 11<sup>th</sup> February, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. In response to his request, we will have a **prayer service** (not Mass) on **Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> February at 1:30 p.m.** here at St. Francis. I encourage you to invite family and friends to join us in this celebration.

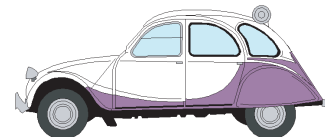
