Solomon wrote, "A truthful witness gives honest testimony but a false witness tells lies:" (Prov. 12:17),

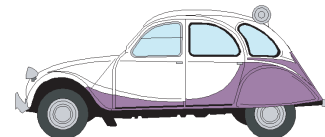
