SCRIPTURE NOTES

GOD WILL PROVIDE

The miracles in today's readings reveal the extraordinary way God may provide for our needs. Elisha and Jesus had to meet the needs of many people with very little food. As we attempt to follow on Christ's path of charity and compassion, we may find that our desire to do His will seems to be beyond our human abilities. We may wonder where we are going to find the means to accomplish what is good and necessary. In today's gospel, Jesus tells the disciples to feed the crowd but they thought it was impossible.



Jesus made it possible. The miracles in today's readings reveal the extraordinary ways that God sometimes provides for the needs in the life of the church and in our own lives. In order to sustain our hopes and work we have to trust that God will give us what we need to accomplish His work. The second reading reminds us that whatever gifts He gives us are given for his work and to build a unified community. We have to use His gifts with humility, meekness and patience.

Lord, guide us in doing your work by helping us to use wisely the gifts you have given us. Help us to remember the last analysis it is your accomplishment and not ours.

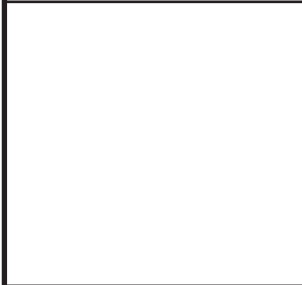
