GOSPEL REFLECTIONS

COME TO ME!

Jesus had an intimate relationship with his Father and wanted to share this experience with us. Though these encounters were times of peaceful refuge, Christ remained focussed on his mission. Jesus showed us a way to freedom by proposing a spiritual relationship with our divine and loving Father. He wanted to lighten our lives and change our perspective. With Jesus, everything is possible.

Though St. Matthew acknowledged the role that intellect plays in our faith life, he also knew that God's divine wisdom reached out to simple people. If we maintain our capacity for wonder, we will see beauty in the hearts of others and realize that Jesus came to lighten our burdens. *Come to me!* When he spoke to the Pharisees, Christ's intention was to breathe new life into the Torah. This life would transform us since the greatest Commandment is to love.

Following Jesus' example, Christians give priority to people rather than to institutions, however valuable and noble their purposes may be. This is eloquently expressed by Gilles Vignault's words: "Love tenderness on our part will free others by lightening their heavy hearts." Jesus inspires us - he breathes new life into our souls and teaches us to apply God's law of love instead of adhering to the restrictions of man-made rules and regulations.


