PLANTING SEEDS

Planting time reminds us that it is always time to sow the seed of the Kingdom. There is no time to begin, no time to stop. Only when time is no more can sowers in the Kingdom rest from their labors. We have an incorruptible seed (1 Pet. 1:23) which is the word of the kingdom (Luke 8:11; Matt. 13:19). Sowers in the Kingdom must be "instant in season and out of season" (2 Tim. 4:2).

Sowers reap what they sow (Gal. 6:7). Those who wish to reap the sweet fruit of the great Kingdom of God must sow the certified seed of the gospel of Christ (Gal. 1:11). Anything other will produce nothing but a corrupt crop (Matt. 15:13).

As workers in the Kingdom today, let each of us be reminded of the urgent duty we have to spread this vital message. God's people once heard the stinging rebuke, "Is the seed still in the barn?" (Hag. 2:19). Seed never does what God intends for it until and unless it is sown in to the hearts of sinners.

"Are you sowing the seed of the Kingdom, brother?" Look around you; see the teeming masses of people who are lost and destined for eternal ruin. You have the power to save them in the ancient gospel of Christ (Rom. 1:16-17).

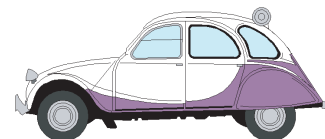
