He is a student from St. Augustine's Seminary and as part of his studies he will be working to get pastoral experience in our parish. He is originally from Ottawa and because of the union that will soon take place the bishop would like to give him an experience in Cornwall.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

During the next few months, there will be extensive work being done in our parish. First of all, we have had a leak in the roof of the rectory and it has been repaired, but because the roof is 30 years of age, we were told that we would be better to put a new roof on than to continue patching. Tenders were put out and Brownlee Construction has been awarded the contract and this work is scheduled for the month of June at a cost of \$10,000.

Second, you may remember that a few years ago, we worked on phase 1 of the water problem in the Church Hall. We went down to the foundation in order to waterproof and to secure the area. This seemed to have worked and we have had no water problems in the elevator shaft or the washroom areas. This year we will be doing a similar project at the front end of the church, underneath the stairs. We have had considerable water damage in the St. Vincent de Paul area and we are going to correct by using the same treatment that was used at the other end of the Hall. The contract has been awarded to CMG Innovation and the cost of this project will be close to \$40,000, and is scheduled for the month of July.

Our third project will be renewing the flooring in the Church. You may have noticed that we have been using duct tape on part of the carpet that was fraying and causing a trip hazard. The existing flooring was installed when the church was renewed 24 years ago. Again, tenders were put out and three companies responded, and the finance council opted to go with the lowest bidder which was Mainville Flooring. The cost of this project will be approximately \$54,000 and it should be done in the month of August.
