ASH WEDNESDAY & LENTEN OBSERVANCE

Ash Wednesday (6th March) and Good Friday (19th April) are days of fast and abstinence. Friday's are days of abstinence.

Fasting binds all persons from 18-59 years, unless prevented by poor health. On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's own needs. Eating between meals is not allowed, although fluids may be taken.

Abstinence from meat binds all persons who are 14 and older, unless prevented by poor health. In the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall, the consumption of meat is not allowed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Friday's of Lent. The Bishop mandates this observance for the spiritual well-being of the faithful.
