RENOVATIONS

Beginning on 16th May we will be beginning some repair work at St. Francis Parish. This repair work is necessary because of insurance regulations concerning dangers of slipping and falling, plus the ongoing problems of water.

The first stage, which will begin on 16th May, involves reconstruction and repair to the sidewalks and stairs that lead to the rectory. Some alterations will be made to help with the run-off of water because there is some pooling in front of the entrance to the hall. The landscaping in front of the rectory will be changed in order to have a greater run-off for water and at the same time we will be renewing the landscaping in front of the rectory and in the flower boxes on the steps of the church. Involved with this first stage we will also be removing a small bit of asbestos that is underneath the sun room of the rectory.

In stage 2, we will be trying to address the water problem in the elevator shaft by repairing some work and again by trying to elevate the run-off away from the building. The second stage will not, unfortunately, begin until late summer.

ATTENTION PLEASE!

During the renovations in front of the church, we ask for your co-operation. For the period of two weeks involving the front section, we are going to ask you to use the main entrance of the church to have access to the office during office hours. We are going to ask those using the services of the St. Vincent de Paul to use the back entrance and the ramp. This is done for safety reasons. Thank you for your co-operation.

THE FUTURE OF THE DIOCESE

As part of his mandate as Apostolic Administrator, Archbishop Prendergast has begun a process of consultation that will include at the early stages an analysis of the Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) of our Catholic life in Christ in the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall. This will involve the clergy, diocesan staff and members of parish pastoral and finance councils.

The findings of this initial step will be shared with the people of the Diocese in September, when all will have a chance to give input into the recommendations that will be made to the Holy See (Vatican). During this period, he asks that we pray regularly the Prayer of the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall.

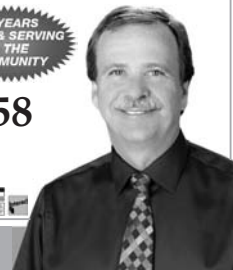

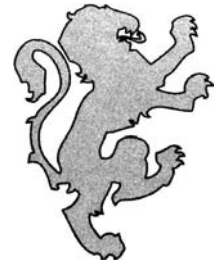
