#### LET'S MAKE CANADA A CLIMATE LEADER!


In December, world leaders will be meeting in Parish at the United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP21) to negotiate

a binding and universal agreement on the world's climate. For this agreement to be effective at avoiding future climate-related disasters, the global temperature can't rise more than 2 deg C over the coming years. In order to achieve this, however, countries like Canada will need to transition to renewable energies and move away from fossil fuels. Sign Development & Peace's Action Card, which will be distributed on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, asking the Prime Minister to sign on to an agreement at COP21 that sets the target to keep the rise in temperature below 2 deg C and to be a leader in achieving that target. On the card, you can also share with the Prime Minister your own personal action to help reduce climate change. The survival of our planet and its people is at stake!
