**ADVENT WREATH IN THE CATHOLIC LITURGY**

The underlying symbolism is the accumulation of light as an expression of the growing anticipation of the birth of Jesus Christ, who is the light of the world. The circular wreath is meant to represent God's eternity as it has no beginning or end. The evergreens are also a symbol of everlasting life.

In the Catholic tradition, three of the candles are violet-coloured and one is rose-coloured. The violet candles symbolize faithful expectation and the rose candle symbolizes joy and hope. These colours mirror the colours of the priest's vestments used during Sunday's of Advent. In earlier times, the season of Advent had stronger penitential and austere aspects, and a relaxation of disciplines was offered on the third Sunday of Advent, called *Gaudete Sunday*, from the Latin for 'rejoice'. This in turn is reflected in the shift from violet to rose. One violet candle is lit on the first evening of Advent (Sunday). On successive Sundays, the second violet candle is added, then the rose candle on Gaudete Sunday, and finally, the third violet candle.
