THE ADVENT WREATH



The underlying symbolism is the accumulation of light as an expression of the growing anticipation of the birth of Jesus Christ, who is the light of the world. The circular wreath is meant to represent God's eternity as it has no beginning or

end. The evergreens are also a symbol of everlasting life. In earlier times, Advent had a stronger penitential aspect, and a relaxation of disciplines was offered on the third Sunday of Advent, called *Gaudete Sunday*. One violet candle is lit on the first evening of Advent (Sunday). On successive Sunday's, the second candle is added, then the rose candle on Gaudete Sunday, and finally, the third violet candle.
