Development and Peace

This fall, we are continuing the campaign against global hunger, **One Human Family, Food for All**, that was launched by Pope Francis on 10 December 2013. This fall's slogan is **Sow Much Love**. Fr. Kevin spoke to us last weekend about the importance of the 'seed'. For the family farmers in the Global South it is their livelihood because they feed their families and sell the surplus of their crops within their communities. They rely on saving their seeds from year to year and exchanging them with other farmers which strengthens the seed and thereby their crops from climate change and disease.


Large corporations are threatening the livelihoods of these farmers by introducing genetically modified seeds, patenting these life forms and using intellectual property rights and trade agreements to acquire a monopoly on them. It forces farmers to have to incur the expense of buying these seeds year after year reducing their independence and control over their own crops.

Read more about the plight of the family farmer in next week's bulletin insert and sign the petition to the House of Commons demanding respect for the right of the small-scale family farmer to preserve, exchange and use seeds.
