PRIESTS' PENSION PLAN

The priests' pension plan currently provides a monthly pension of \$750. Our goal is to increase the amount to \$1,100 in order to meet monthly living expenses. Considering the current cost of rent, cable, telephone, internet, food, automobilie expenses, clothing, entertainment and some amount for miscellaneous, we require about \$2,100 monthly. CPP and OAS provide approximately \$1,000 monthly. This gives us the \$1,100 we have set for our pension goal. We will work gradually to reach this level. The current \$750 will be raised to \$800 per month effective 1st July 2014. We thank you for your generosity as you contemplate your contribution this year.
