**PRIESTS' PENSION COLLECTION**

The priests' pension plan annual collection will take place Sunday, 6 November. Last year's collection generated \$55,620. We are very appreciative of your concern for our welfare. You may recall that when we began seeking your help, the monthly pension was at \$750. The number of retired priests outnumber the active priests by a ratio of almost 2 to 1. In July of 2014, we were able to raise the pension to \$800 per month. Our target is to reach \$1,100 and we had hoped to implement another adjustment to \$875 per month effective of 1 July 2016. However, because of continued falling interest rates plus the longevity of our members (people are living longer therefore more money is required to pay the monthly pension), we have had to postpone increasing the monthly pension this year. We need to save enough to be able to pay the pension at the current \$800 per month for all members for the whole of their retirement before we can consider a change. 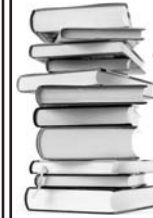

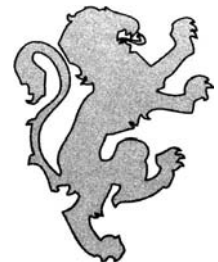
