WHO IS A SERVANT?

He gave himself, making the ultimate sacrifice—dying—for others; he willingly laid down his life because of his love for the whole world. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son..." 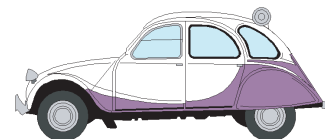
