The retired priests outnumber the active priests by a ratio of almost 2 to 1, which, combined with the low interest earnings and market volatility, meant we needed to seek additional sources of income. You have responded to our requests which have allowed us to increase the monthly pension to \$800/month effective 1st July 2014. Our annual collection this year will take place 1st November weekend.
