PRIEST'S PENSION FUND

The priests' pension plan annual collection will take place Sunday, 3rd November. Last year's collection generated \$65,318. We are very appreciative of your concern for our welfare. You may recall that when we began seeking your help, the monthly pension was at \$750. The number of retired priests outnumber the active priests by a ratio of almost 2 to 1. In July of 2014, we were able to raise the pension to \$800 per month with an eventual target of \$1,100. Continued low interest rates, plus the fact that people are living longer have delayed any increases in the monthly pension. The plan must be capable of covering all current obligations before we can consider a change. The pension will hopefully be able to be increased soon with a significant thanks to your generosity.
