PRIESTS' PENSION FUND - (EMBS PENSION PLAN)

The priests' pension plan annual collection will take place Sunday, 4th November 2018. Last year's collection generated \$66,581. We are very appreciative of your concern for our welfare. You may recall that when we began seeking your help, the monthly pension was at \$750. The number of retired priests outnumber the active priests by a ratio of almost 2 to 1. In July of 2014, we were able to raise the pension to \$800 per month. Our target is to reach \$1,100 and we had hoped to implement another adjustment to \$875 per month effective 1st July 2016. However, because of continued low interest rates, plus a change in the mortality experience (people are living longer therefore more money is required to pay the monthly pension), we have had to postpone increasing the monthly pension. There is a current deficit that must first be eliminated before we can consider a change and this will likely take a few years. We thank you for your consideration and generosity.
