**ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY NEWS**

At the last Parish Council meeting it was suggested that we provide you, our regular contributors, with a more regular update of our activities to give you an appreciation for what is being done in your name. On average, we provide emergency food to some 390 people per month and in September we assisted 463 clients. We had 54 new clients register with us in September, bringing this year's total for new client registration to 274. It remains apparent that a genuine need for our Food Bank services exists in this, our community. Our Christmas Basket Giveaway initiative is underway, with client sign-up dates of 14<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> November, with distribution on 16<sup>th</sup> December.


