**PRIESTS' PENSION COLLECTION - 1<sup>ST</sup> NOVEMBER 2015**

Due to your generosity, we were able to increase the monthly pension from \$750 to \$800 effective 1 July 2014. Considering the current cost of rent, cable, telephone, internet, food, automobile expenses, clothing, entertainment and some amount for miscellaneous, we require about \$2,100 monthly. CPP and OAS provide approximately \$1,000 monthly. This gives us the \$1,100 we have set for our pension goal. We will work gradually to reach this level and are hoping to increase the monthly pension to \$875 effective 1 July 2016. We thank you for your generosity as you contemplate your contribution this year. The collection will take place the weekend of 1<sup>st</sup> November. 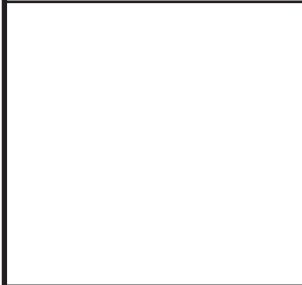
