PRIESTS' PENSION PLAN

Some highlights of the information we had provided last year are:

- We have 31 priests incardinated in our diocese including 2 past bishops.
- 20 of our priests (65%) are over 65 years of age and are currently receiving a pension.
- 8 of the priests over 65 are in charge of one or more parishes.
- 9 priests are under age 65 and are in charge of one or more parishes.
- Our active priests receive a modest salary of \$33,853 per year from which they have to pay rent to the parish, maintain an automobile and look after other personal living expenses.

We ask that you be generous when you contemplate your contribution this year.
